Prior to the joint meeting with the Lions, there was a meeting to discuss purchasing 5 signs to be placed around town that will welcome visitors to Lexington and display individual signs for various organizations in town. Our speaker was Hasan U. who updated us on the status of our matching grant project to supply much needed medical equipment to the Abbottabad hospital and medical school that were damaged by a major earthquake. Through the matching grant submitted by our club and the efforts of Hasan, we were able to ship \$500,000 worth of medical equipment to Pakistan. The equipment has now arrived and is being cataloged at the Disaster Management Center (DMC) from which it will be distributed to the appropriate departments within the hospital. As the hospital is run by the government and a new administration is about to take control, the DMC is holding the equipment until the new hospital administration is in place. Hasan shared with us pictures of buildings that still show evidence of earthquake damage but are being used and previously donated medical equipment that is being put to good use. He also shared with us pictures of his experiences with members of the Rotary Club of Abottabad. Thanks again to Hasan for all his efforts on the matching grant and following the progress of the shipment of equipment to its ultimate destination.

The 50:50 raffle was for \$70 and was won by SAA Sean.
