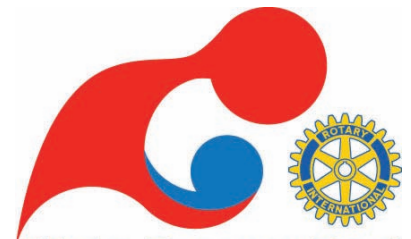

Our speakers today were Florence Del Santo, Executive Director of Lex Media www.lexmedia.org Public Access TV, and Scott Counsel, Community Outreach Coordinator for LexMedia. Lex Media receives 4.5% (approx \$240,000/yr) of a 5% payment the cable providers are required to pay to the Town of Lexington's Cable Advisory Committee. LexMedia's current subscriber list is approximately 9600 households (Comcast, RCN & Verizon). Subscriptions are up and they have been very busy with phone calls for services.

LexMedia's mission is to develop, establish and maintain a Media Center to facilitate learning and to meet the needs of the Lexington community by offering media education and community programming.

They are provided free office space (approx 6000sf) at Avalon at Lexington Hills at the newly renovated Metropolitan State Hospital grounds.

LexMedia services include;

- Taping and broadcasting of all Selectmen and School Committee meetings, Town Meetings and other Town Committee Meetings.
- Providing Digital video equipment available for your LexMedia production
- Providing a televised Community Bulletin Board (CBB) to post community events for viewing by cable subscribers
- Provide training in editing, audio and video
