

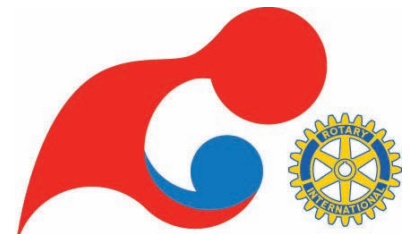

A little piece of interesting history, Connie – it was in 1987 that our PP Dave E., as Club President helped induct our first woman member. Many people, including Bob S. were wondering if the club should open to women and now our very own Bob S. is participating – we have come a long way and thank both Dave and Bob for their service to our club in many capacities.

Some announcements: PP Jack D. said that Patriot’s Day is all set – he is working on it. PP Dan B. announced the opening of a new facility in Woburn–Congratulations, Dan! An idea by President Spencer about the possibility of having a social get-together at the Merrimack Repertory Theatre was presented. It would be either a comedy or drama, from which we could choose, and the cost would be \$30 per ticket, plus any other incidental costs. President Spencer will get back to the club on this.

Our speaker for the meeting was: Mr. Flemming Lund, introduced by David B. Flemming is the founder and sole operator of Infrared Diagnostic LLC. His company does energy audits, in order to see how much energy homes are losing, especially in terms of heat and, also, cool air in the summertime. Flemming, a certified building science thermographer and a licensed home inspector, inspects and diagnosis these problems for both commercial and home residences. The best time to have his energy audit service is when there is at least a 20o difference between the inside and outside temperature, and this would be especially true during the months of October thru April, however, he will do it in other months, too, if conditions are satisfactory. His plan includes the following: 1. A \$1600 infrared sensor, is the tool he uses, and he will be able to get digital recordings of various items, such as air flow, heat loss, temperature readings of various areas and studies of pressures to see air flow, and, 2. The actual energy audit, which he tries to prepare on the day of the inspection, and then it get out to the client that same day.
