Our speaker today was Dr. Bernard L. Huang from Lexington. Dr. Huang took us on a virtual tour of

China and presented the nation's history as he has witnessed and documented it since the early 1970's. Dr Huang currently performs cardiothoracic surgery at eight Boston area hospitals and is a clinical instructor in thoracic surgery department at Boston University School of Medicine. Dr Huang holds his degree in medicine from BUSM, class of 1962.

Dr. Huang came to America from China at the age of 17 and began his education here in America. In 1973 he was the first American physician to gain entry to China and had a chance to re-visit his home country after so many years in America.

Dr. Huang spoke today about the cultural and political revolution in China that has shaped the nation with a rapid determination to shed its past political and social doctrine.

Dr Huang has captured this Cultural Revolution through his pictures and extensive knowledge of China past and present. Notable point was that how quickly the people of China have emerged in to a new era of personal freedom and capitalism. And away from the communist form of governing it's people.

Dr. Huang's perspective on life and pragmatism is infectious and refreshing. Refreshing to hear that the world is respectful of the past, but it's time to move on. Socialism has not worked in China and it may have emerged into a new era of freedom.
