

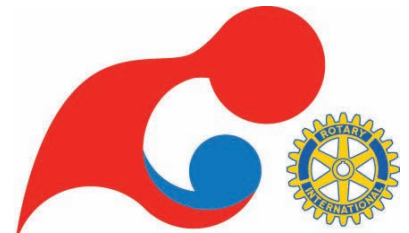

Pres. Spencer read out a thank you letter from one of our scholarship recipients, Alexis, and invited everyone to be present at the installation lunch next week for our new president, Doug H. Our speaker was Lexington author, entrepreneur, angel investor and Franklin Olin College of Engineering faculty member Steven K. Gold. Steven’s talk focused on the “Accidental Entrepreneur,” a person who is thrust into entrepreneurship because of difficult circumstances rather than some inherent entrepreneurial drive. Such individuals might include college students graduating in the off-cycle when recruiters don’t normally come to campus with jobs, people who lose or quit jobs because of industry retrenchment or unhappiness with their daily grind, and recent retirees not too crazy about retirement. These people must Just Do It! They can’t wait for some VC to get around to approving funding for their business plan. The non-fresh-college-grads have strengths they can tap into to get going – their contact list, understanding of an industry, business relationships, and knowledge of how the world operates. Steven outlined three things that are critical ingredients for an Accidental Entrepreneur’s success: 1) Strategic Thinking; 2) Resourcefulness; 3) Effective Communications. There were lots of questions and discussion.
