Lexington Rotary Newsletter November 2, 2009

On a cool cloudy afternoon President Doug opened the 15th meeting of his administration. The pledge was led by PP.Jack D, and singing led by PP Jim F. PP “Reverend “ Dan L. has given so many invocations he must now have a direct line to the Lord. We can be assured that his prayers on our behalf are being heard.

PP Nick C gave a volunteer fine for having a vacation, but decided that paying for those days over 90 degrees were not worth a donation. He managed to fine himself \$20.00 anyway.

The board of directors met today for their monthly session, and President Doug reminded us that we need everyone to promptly respond to their dues bills. If you have not paid to date, please do so now. The funds are needed to meet our obligations. President Doug reported on the club role in packaging and shipping “care” packages for our troops in Iraq and Afghanistan. We are on track to distribute about 25 free turkey dinners to needy Lexington families for Thanksgiving.

We need new raffle prizes. Perhaps you have a gift or other item in the house that you don’t want, and have never used.

PP Jack D reported that all but 3 tickets out of 300 raffle tickets have been handed out. He has collected \$15,000.00 of the \$30,000.00 we need for a successful raffle. As this is our main fund raiser, please sell and turn in your money. This is a commitment for all club members that must be met.

VP David B. introduced the speakers for the day from the Town of Lexington Human Services Department, Assistant Director Emily Lavine, and Assistant Director of Youth Services Laurie Henry. They explained that the new Human Services Department is a combination of many different departments previously administered separately. The Human Services Department, headed by Director Charlotte Rogers, now includes human services, youth services, senior services, veterans services, and meals on wheels, each with their own staff leader. By having all these town services under Charlotte Rogers, there is better management and co-ordination than previously. The service areas now under one roof include, information and referral, needs assessment and service coordination for mental health, financial needs, fuel assistance, and senior specific assistance. Additional areas include case management services for individual across the lifespan, crisis intervention, collaboration with community based youth, family and senior services, community service opportunities for youth, intergenerational programming, school consultation services, youth programs, and veterans assistance. Also available at the meeting were several copies of the resources available in Metro Boston in such areas as housing and homelessness, legal immigrant services, legal services, suicide prevention, teen pregnancy, and unemployment, among many other topics. In this time of financial need, many people need help.

Director Rogers and the presenters participated in a question and answer period that showed what they offered, and what Rotarians felt about what they were doing. It was a learning experience for all involved. Rotarians now have a better idea of how the town supports human services. The club now has one place to go for helping the Town of Lexington in the area of human services that the club has supported for years. PPDan L is the Lexington Rotary Club representative to the Fund for Lexington, and he reported on how the fund contributes with matching grants.

PP Dan Busa, Jr. won the 50/50 and donated it to the Fund for Lexington.
