From August 2009 to the present there have been 5 new businesses established in Lexington Center. The Center Committee has been able to change some of the zoning by-laws for downtown Lexington. Most of the zoning by-laws are over 20 years old. The changes that have allowed new types of business for Lexington Center include; indoor exercise, laundry, private postal, advertising and artistic studios. Susan realizes that it takes a long time for zoning changes to take effect so she is taking the long term view of adding businesses downtown. Susan is also working on a guide to opening a store in Lexington, so business owners will know what approvals are needed. Other open issues are; too many banks, parking, signage and building heights. Susan realizes that the rules need to be updated and made easier for people to understand to improve Lexington Center.
