Professor Rotberg discussed what Haiti needs to be re-constructed and suggested we contact our representatives to voice our views about long-term re-construction efforts. These needs include: (1) jobs; (2) trees (only 1% of Haiti is tree covered); (3) for people to buy clothes made in Haiti; (4) tourism; (5) improved governance; and (6) encouraging the Haitian diaspora to invest in Haiti.

Pres. Doug H. made Professor Rotberg a Paul Harris Fellow, and Professor Rotberg was truly touched.
