March 15, 2010

On a rain stormy day, 21 Rotarians and 2 visiting Rotarians met to enjoy chicken tortellini and cold cut sandwiches. One guest, Reverend John Lombard from the Concord club, was kind enough to give us a most beautiful invocation.

Charlie V asked the two guests to stand and Charlie then led us in the welcome song. PP Dan O commented that he was impressed that we were on key through out the song and gave \$1. (How in the world would he know? Dentists lose hearing after years working with high speed drills).

Raffle gifts were courtesy of Lexington Credit Union, Sperry Van Ness and Busa Liquors. Winners were PP Jim F, Hassan U, and PP Dan O but PP Don S actually held this winning ticket (see fine next paragraph).

Because today's meeting most approximated St. Patrick's Day, President Doug asked for anyone with even slight Irish heritage be fined \$1. Five members and our guest speaker paid up. Hassan gave \$1 because he went to a Catholic parochial school growing up. PP Don S and PP Dan O were fined \$1 each for childish behavior. PP Don M gave \$2 for Rev Lombard's beautiful invocation. Pres Elect Dave B was fined \$1 for thinking district 7930 had 30 clubs when the actual number is 46.

All of us are aware, RI has been seeking to raise \$200 million over the next three years to match the \$350 Gates Foundation gift to Polio Plus. President Doug said that \$114 million has been collected so far from Rotary Clubs.

PP Dave E announced that there are still plenty of comedy night tickets for sale. Those members who have not seen PPDave E or PP John O' about tickets, please come forward and claim your tables and seats.

Our speaker was PP Jim Major of the Woburn Rotary Club. Jim will be next year's District Annual Giving Chair. He talked to us about the evolution of the Rotary Foundation which was started in 1917 by Arch Klump with \$26. By 1928 the endowment rose to \$5,000. The foundation had five trustees which included Klump. In 1930 the foundation gave \$500 to the organization that was precursor to the March of Dimes. In 1947 when Paul Harris passed away the foundation was inundated with gifts. In the 50's the Ambassadorial Scholarship Fund was founded. In the 60's the Global Student Exchange was founded. In 1984 the Polio Plus program was started. In 1987 the Peace and Conflict Study Program was set up. The Rotary Foundation today has well over \$1 billion.

Jim reviewed how foundation money will be distributed to our district. Of the money our district funds the endowment, 50% is returned to the district three years later. Half of this money will be available for chapters to fund local projects individually or partnering with other clubs. The other half of the money received will be available to fund projects put forth by district 7930 club(s) outside of our country. Rotary's Future Vision Plan has identified 6 areas that we want to concentrate our funding efforts. There is still much to clarify on the mechanics of the Future Vision Plan. District 7930 is one of the 100 districts chosen to experience (experiment) how this program can be effectively implemented during the next three years.

PDG Jack M won the 50:50.
