She started with her back tire in the Atlantic Ocean in St. Augustine FL and finished 48 days, 8 states, and 2200 miles later with her front tire in the Pacific Ocean in San Diego CA surrounded by family that flew in to see her finish. She overcame 6 flats, reckless trucks, chasing dogs, high altitudes, head winds, and freezing cold to accomplish her feat. She met a lot of people along the way and drew strength from them.
