June 14, 2010

The Club met on a partly sunny 75 degree day. There were 28 Rotarians, one Visiting Rotarian and two Visitors for a total of 31 in attendance. Lunch was the usual salad, sandwiches, and stuffed shells with chocolate chip cookies for dessert. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Don M.; America was led by PP Dan B.; and, the invocation was offered by PP Dan L. The Visiting Rotarian was ADG Christina H. from the Ipswich Club.

PP Nick C. offered up fines for not having any guests at his table, and also suggested fines from Pres.-Elect David B.'s table for stealing his guests. PP John O. offered Happy Dollars for his son graduating Dartmouth College. PP Dan B. offered Happy Dollars for his Dad (aka "Silver Fox") who has been moved to a rehab facility close to home; and, told a joke about "tighty whities" and a medical condition that I'm not sure I can put in print. Secy Dave S. offered a fine for his future absences and something about his wife's bad back. PDG Jack M. offered Happy Dollars for his Granddaughter's Christening (4th one, I believe).

Pres. Doug H. made several announcements including his attending a new Boston Rotary Club evening meeting, Rotary matching funds for international grants are back and other items. He read a thank you note from a scholarship recipient, Miles Adley. Pres.-Elect David B. noted that the grant applications needed to be submitted by the end of September, 2010. 2nd VP David S. will be acting President for the 6/21/10 meeting since Pres. Doug H. will be in Montreal for the Rotary International Convention. PP Spencer B. asked for help in getting speakers for the 2010/2011 year, including a speaker for the 2010 Thanksgiving Lunch that is being hosted by the Lexington Rotary.

Pres. Doug H. also noted that there are no Rotary members from ANY of the businesses on Hartwell Avenue. The last meeting of his year as President will be 6/28/10 and he made a special request for 100% turnout at Pres.-Elect David B.'s induction on that day. Pres.-Elect David B. announced the Lexington Symphony would be sending a Trio to perform at the induction (PP Spencer B. noted it was "half a six-pack") PP Dan B. needs some help from the members in getting an accurate count for his guest list – please respond to his email request. Lastly, Pres. Doug H. auctioned off a dog statue/door stop, reportedly worth \$17.95. It went to PP Dan O. for \$50.

The speaker was Jim Edholm who explained what the new National Health Plan will mean to business owners. The talk was very informative about the impact coming in two phases: 2010 - 2014 and 2014 and beyond. For Phase I, there will not be a big impact to Massachusetts businesses as many of the Federal provisions are already in place under MA law. However, in 2014, one of the biggest provisions that will impact businesses will be the \$2,000 fine per employee not covered; in many cases, the cost to pay the fine would be less than the cost of the insurance not provided, which may have unintended consequences. He noted that healthcare costs are as high as they are due to consumers generally not being aware of what they are buying, so they don't know where to go for service. Often, it is the hospitals providing high quality services that have the lowest cost. Also, market power and reputation significantly impact the costs. Lastly, MA has begun looking into the insurance rates being set and have frozen rates; businesses need to be aware that when the issue is resolved, the rates will be retroactively applied back to April 2010.

Raffle donations were provided by Walpole Coop and WBC; the winners were Murray A. and Pres.-Elect David B. PP David O. won the 50/50.

The next meeting will be on 6/21/09. There will not be a meeting on 7/5/10 in honor of July 4th.
