Having been invited by one company to show him what they did, he latter was hired as a project manager for the company.

He explained how he and his wife met a nice waitress who used to work at "Not Your Average Joe's in Lexington and then worked at "Not Your Average Joe's in Arlington. She had impressed him because she had remembered what he and his wife liked for drinks and what their favorite foods were, even though she had not seen them for a while after the Lexington restaurant closed. The waitress managed to get an interview with him and presented new marketing ideas for his company.
